



**REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY**

My brother Andy Bouchard, barged into my Dad's home in ELIE, MANITOBA, WITH A KEY TO BE USED ONLY for emergencies as Dad is 82. My sister from CALGARY WAS on Dad's cellular phone which I passed to him. He left with Dad's only phone. I went to pick up my cell phone. It was gone from its location. Then I noticed my business folder was also missing.

It was a copy revoking "Power of Attorney" in favour of Andy Bouchard, as well as new one dated Jan. 27/06. I got stuck in the snow in the yard & we did not have phones for help. My Dad (82) was released on Friday from Grace Hospital, from a fall on ice & concussion. (after one month)

Would request a peace bond OR no contact order for my Dad & myself as Andy Bouchard barged in 3 times Friday night using the Emergency Key & has been harassing my Dad to try to place him a senior's home at the St. Eustache Manor.

My Dad refuses to go & Andy tried to get him committed when he was in the hospital immediately after the fall where Dad almost died, being rushed in ambulance, in a coma for 1/2 hour & loosing a lot of blood. Andy told me in the hospital that Dad "was not - was not coming home."

Dear Mr. Bradley;

I am writing you with my concerns regarding any possible compensation for my father Lionel Bouchard. Dad had a Power of Attorney drawn up by his lawyer, Chris Christianson of Christianson, Christianson Jones law firm in Portage la Prairie sometime during November 2005 prior to his accident on December 16, 2005. Since the accident, my sister Marlene Legaré has been in contact with you to initiate a liability suite against the insurance company of the Blessed Sacrament Church of St. Eustache. With reservations, the majority of our family members including myself agreed to proceed on behalf of our father since he will need continuous medication to stabilize his condition for an extended period of time and will need to be closely monitored for his long term state of health.

I do not believe my father has made sufficient recovery to make decisions on his own. He continues to be under the doctor's supervision with a health nurse monitoring his medication and his mental state. He tires very easily and gets frustrated and confused a lot. He has clearly not made a complete recovery although he was released from the hospital into the care and supervision of the health nurse. He has clearly shown that he can be manipulated mentally. I do not believe revoking the Power of Attorney is in his best interest. I feel very strongly as a family member that Marlene's involvement has shown to be self-serving for no other reason than financial gain. The majority of the family members do not wish to have Marlene represent our father in this matter.

I ask that in the event of a favorable judgment for my father that the money be put in a Trust fund for his care and well being and not for the financial gain of any single family member.

I trust you will use your best judgment in this delicate family matter. Please respond to the family members who have and will be contacting you.

My name is Helene Johnson (nee Bouchard) and am the fourth daughter of Lionel Bouchard. The reason for this email is that I have many concerns over my father's affairs. I believe that my sister Marlene Legare is not there for my father's best interest. She has lived in British Columbia for the past 35 years and has had very limited contact with our father. Marlene has a long history of borrowing money from family members and either not repaying back her loans or paying them in a very late fashion. I speak from personal experience and not just from hearsay. I believe that she is has her own personal motives for keeping Dad at home by himself and not in as assisted living establishment. My father has many times expressed his desire to live in the local Manor where he will thrive among his friends. Her false pretense of caring for our Dad has nothing but confused him .

My brother Andre and sister Lynda have always been there for our father whenever he has had any financial, personal or health issues. They have routinely visited him over the years and are well aware of his wishes. My brother Andre does not need any monetary compensation from our father as he is financially set in his own right.
