8 MS. LEGARE: Maybe I can bring something up,  
9 there was a revoked power of attorney that he's still  
10 using, even though it's been revoked.

11 THE COURT: Okay.

12 MS. LEGARE: And we would like for him to turn it  
13 in.

14 THE COURT: Okay. I mean that's a -- and that's  
15 a criminal matter, if it's been revoked and it's not there,  
16 it's -- I mean, if he's passing it off, it's something  
17 that --

18 MS. LEGARE: But we were -- it's like we're  
19 always --

20 THE COURT: He needs to be charged criminally  
21 with that. Somebody has to call the police and have them  
22 go and charge him with that.

23 MS. LEGARE: Oh, is that what we do then?

24 THE COURT: Yeah.

25 MS. LEGARE: Okay.

26 THE COURT: Anything that's being done that is  
27 not legal, it's a matter for the police. Yeah.

28 MS. LEGARE: It's, it's like with the bank, we're  
29 going to follow up on it.

30 THE COURT: Yeah, and that's why the bank, the  
31 banker, if he's going to the bank with a power of attorney  
32 that's not in --

33 MS. LEGARE: He's doing something --

34 THE COURT: That's not in effect --
