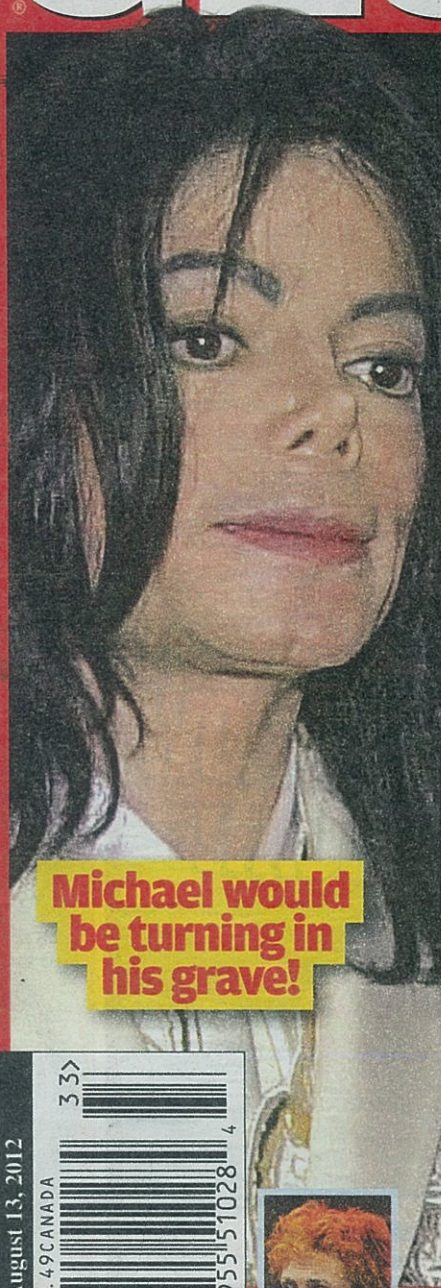

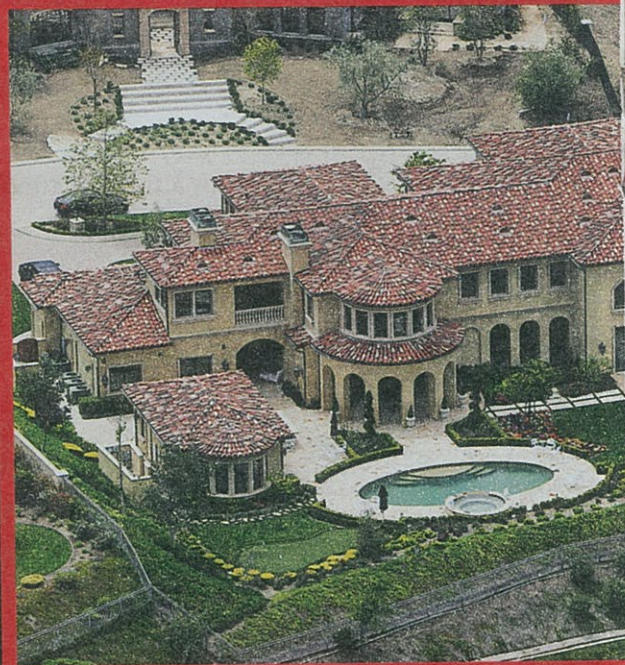

Violence, lies and greed at their House of Horrors

AS charges of kidnapping and threats of violence explode, insiders reveal a chilling portrait of life inside Michael Jackson's family house of horrors.

In a shocking period of less than two weeks, the late Thriller star's mom, Katherine, **was the focus of a kidnap drama by some of her own children**, and his kids Prince, 15, Paris, 14, and Blanket, 10, were put in physical and mental danger by family members' screamests and violence, say sources.

"It's absolutely criminal what was happening," a Jackson family insider tells GLOBE.

"No one is safe, especially Michael's children. The kids are worth millions and **some family members desperately want a piece and are going to drastic means to get their greedy hands on it.**

"Michael would be rolling in his grave if he knew what his brothers and sisters were doing to his children and mother."

Now, in a world exclusive report, GLOBE's sources rip the lid off:

● **The sinister scheme by five Jackson siblings to remove their 82-year-old mom, who is guardian of Michael's kids, from her home, in an apparent plot to get a chunk of the King of Pop's fortune.**

Shameful

● The cruel treatment of ailing Katherine, who was kept from her grandchildren and other family members for nine days – which is leaving some to ask if **she was a victim of elder abuse.**

● How Michael's brother Randy pressured his siblings into going along with the shameful plan.

● The violent brawl inside the family home that put Michael's children in extreme danger of mental and physical injury.

Insiders say the shameful money-grab began as Janet, 46, Randy, 50, Rebbie, 62, Jermaine, 57, and Tito, 58, penned a letter to two executors

running Michael's massive estate demanding their immediate resignations – and charging the Billie Jean legend's will was forged.

The five are furious because they didn't get a dime after Michael died on June 25, 2009. The singer left his billion-dollar fortune to his kids and mom.

Before Katherine was taken away, "Janet went to her two or three times" and tried to convince the elderly family matriarch to sign over custody of Michael's children to Rebbie, says the source.

"Janet was screaming at her mom that they knew what was best for her and she should give the children to Rebbie," says the insider. "Their plan seems to have been to get Rebbie to become the guardian, probably believing they could then manipulate her into giving them money.

"Janet verbally abused her mother, but Katherine wouldn't bow to her wishes."

So the "plotters" spirited away Katherine

from her Calabasas, Calif., home, even though she'd suffered a mini-stroke just days before, says the insider. They apparently told Katherine they were taking her to a concert in Albuquerque, N.M., the insider says.

Instead, she was whisked away to an Arizona spa where "they wouldn't allow her to contact anyone - not her grandchildren, husband Joseph, lawyer - no one!" says the insider.

"The only reason she didn't call anyone was because she wasn't allowed to! She loves Michael's kids more than anything else in the world and the only reason she didn't contact them was she was blocked from making calls!"

For days, the scheming siblings tried yet again to get their mom to make Rebbie guardian of Michael's kids, claims the source.

Randy was the mastermind behind the plot, charges the insider. He pressured Janet, Rebbie, Jermaine and Tito into going along

with him by convincing them it was best for aging Katherine, the insider says.

Jealous

The source says Randy has always been jealous of Michael's success and even used to call his brother "trash."

"Michael absolutely hated Randy," notes the source. "He used to say, 'I don't trust him and I don't want him around me or my kids!'"

Since Michael's death, Randy "has plotted to get some of the money," says the insider. "I think he doesn't care about the kids or his own mother. He wants Michael's money."

Meanwhile, back at the family estate, Michael's young children frantically tried to get in touch with their grandmother. They pleaded with their aunts and uncles to let her go.

When news that Katherine had vanished became public, the plotters reportedly panicked

and rushed to the kids' California home planning to take them to Arizona, too.

"All hell broke loose," says the source. "Everyone was screaming at each other. Janet slapped Paris and called her a 'spoiled little b****.'" "

Paris slapped her aunt back, cursed her out and told her, "This is our house. Get the **** out of here and stay out!"

Paris went online to deny it, but the source says the confrontation was very real.

Nephew Trent Jackson (TJ) reportedly punched Jermaine in the nose and tackled Randy.

"Fists were flying," says the source, "and cops were called!"

Then Katherine's attorney released a statement saying, "One of the family members admitted that a plan has been in place for the last three years to remove Katherine Jackson from her home and her beloved grandchildren."

"Prince, Paris and Blanket had not heard from their grandmother since she left their home nine days ago to attend a series of her sons' concerts on their Unity Tour. She never made the shows."

With their plan in tatters, the schemers allowed Katherine to return home. That same day, she lost custody of her grandchildren when a judge awarded temporary guardianship of the kids to her 34-year-old grandchild T.J., who is Tito's son. But Katherine

was also bullied into saying the whole thing was a misunderstanding and she'd gone away for some much needed rest, says the source.

As she read a prepared statement, Randy, Janet, Jermaine and Rebbie flanked her, looking "like a gang of mobsters watching over her, making sure she wouldn't say anything that would make them look bad," says the source. "But I think Katherine WASN'T telling the truth. She didn't go on her own."

Now, Katherine has agreed to share guardianship of the children with T.J.

And she's reportedly banned Janet, Randy, Rebbie and Jermaine from the home she shares with Michael's kids.

As she recovered from her ordeal, Katherine told a source, "It was the worst week of my life outside of Michael's death."

Prince, Paris & Blanket TRAPPED in violent war over blood money...

MICHAEL JACKSON'S three kids are in real danger - not from strangers - but from their own greedy aunts and uncles. That's the chilling opinion of mental health experts who are calling for child protective services to save Prince, Paris and Blanket from physical and psychological injury as their money-grubbing kin use them as pawns in a battle for control over their father's billion-dollar fortune.

"Prince has expressed that his father repeatedly warned him about 'certain people' in the family," notes New York psychotherapist Dr. Jamie Turndorf.

"Now it's getting more dangerous for them as the stakes are higher and Michael is no longer around to protect them.

"Child protective services needs to step in and provide a safe place for those children. They need third-party intervention, not more Jacksons to watch over them while tearing their world apart."

The danger has already reached frightening heights as evidenced by Janet Jackson barging into the kids' Calabasas, Calif., home and physically confronting Paris, says Turndorf, author of Till Death Do Us Part - Unless I Kill You First.

Beverly Hills therapist Carla Lundblade charges the chilling showdown between Paris and her aunt is "abuse."

"Whenever an adult is violent toward a child, it is abuse," says Lundblade.

Slugfests have also broken out between male family members - and Turndorf says the scrapes

can escalate to horrific levels.

"Once the fighting becomes physical, the children are in real danger," warns Turndorf.

"Words become fists, fists become knives, knives become guns and it only gets worse."

Indeed, Michael's children have been living in the shadow of violence for some time.

In 2010, L.A. county child welfare officials went to the family's

Encino compound on two consecutive days following reports that a young cousin ordered at least one stun gun, possibly two, over the Internet to use on Michael's youngest child Blanket!

Lundblade says, "These three children have already suffered a tragic and very graphic loss with the death of their father.

"Now they are plunged into more insecurity by the back-

stabbing actions of their aunts and uncles. They need to be protected by a third party who has only their best interests at heart."

Adds Turndorf, "The children have already been psychologically damaged by family feuding - because if it's happening now, it certainly has happened in the past."
