COMMON NAME: VALACYCLOVIR (VAL-ay-SYE-kloe-vir)

COMMON USES: This medicine is an antiviral used for treating shingles (herpes zoster), cold sores (fever blisters or herpes labialis), and treating, suppressing, or reducing transmission of genital herpes in patients with normal immune systems. It is also used to treat chickenpox in children and teenagers. It is also used to suppress genital herpes in patients with HIV infection.

BEFORE USING THIS MEDICINE: Some medicines or medical conditions may interact with this medicine. INFORM YOUR DOCTOR OR PHARMACIST of all prescription and over-the-counter medicine that you are taking. DO NOT START OR STOP any medicine without doctor or pharmacist approval. Inform your doctor of any other medical conditions, including HIV or AIDS; kidney problems; pregnancy; allergies; or breast-feeding. Tell your doctor if you have had a bone marrow or kidney transplant. Contact your doctor or pharmacist if you have any questions or concerns about using this medicine.

HOW TO USE THIS MEDICINE: Follow the directions for taking this medicine provided by your doctor. TAKE THIS MEDICINE with or without food. If stomach upset occurs, take with food to reduce stomach irritation. DRINKING EXTRA FLUIDS while you are taking this medicine is recommended. Check with your doctor for instructions. STORE THIS MEDICINE between 59 and 77 degrees F (15 and 25 degrees C) away from heat, moisture, and light. Do not store in the bathroom. TO TREAT COLD SORES, CHICKENPOX, SHINGLES, OR GENITAL HERPES, start treatment as soon as possible after your symptoms start. IF TREATING AN ACUTE OUTBREAK, use this medicine for the full course of treatment. Keep using it even if you feel better in a few days. FOR SUPPRESSIVE THERAPY, this medicine works best if it is taken at the same time each day. IF YOU MISS A DOSE OF THIS MEDICINE, take it as soon as possible. If it is almost time for your next dose, skip the missed dose and go back to your regular dosing schedule. DO NOT take 2 doses at once.

CAUTIONS: DO NOT USE THIS MEDICINE IF you are allergic to any ingredient in this medicine or to acyclovir. LAB TESTS, including complete blood cell counts, kidney function, and liver function, may be performed to monitor your condition or check for side effects. Keep all doctor and lab appointments while you are taking this medicine. THIS MEDICINE MAY CAUSE DIZZINESS. This effect may be worse if you take it with alcohol or certain medicines. Use this medicine with caution. DO NOT DRIVE OR PERFORM OTHER POSSIBLY UNSAFE TASKS until you know how you react to it. SAFER SEX PRACTICES can lower the chances of passing genital herpes to your partner. Do NOT have sexual contact with your partner when you have any symptoms or outbreak of genital herpes. USE A CONDOM made of latex or polyurethane whenever you have sexual contact. BEFORE YOU BEGIN TAKING ANY NEW MEDICINES, either prescription or


To Whom It May Concern:

Mr. Bouchard is a patient of ours. He visited our office today reporting that his left hearing aid was creating some static. The hearing aid was cleaned and checked and found to have an unusually high degree of circuit noise that might interfere with speech understanding. The Workers Compensation Board of Manitoba supplies Mr. Bouchard with hearing aids every five years provided they are not under a repair warranty. The right aid was repaired in September of this year and continues to be in good working order. In March the hearing aids can be replaced. If we were to send the left aid back for repair, Mr. Bouchard would have to wait another six months before WCB Manitoba would replace them. Even with the use of two hearing aids, Mr. Bouchard can expect to understand approximately 65% of conversation in quiet situations.

These options were explained to Mr. Bouchard and he has chosen not to send the left aid for repair but to wait for new aids in March of 2011.

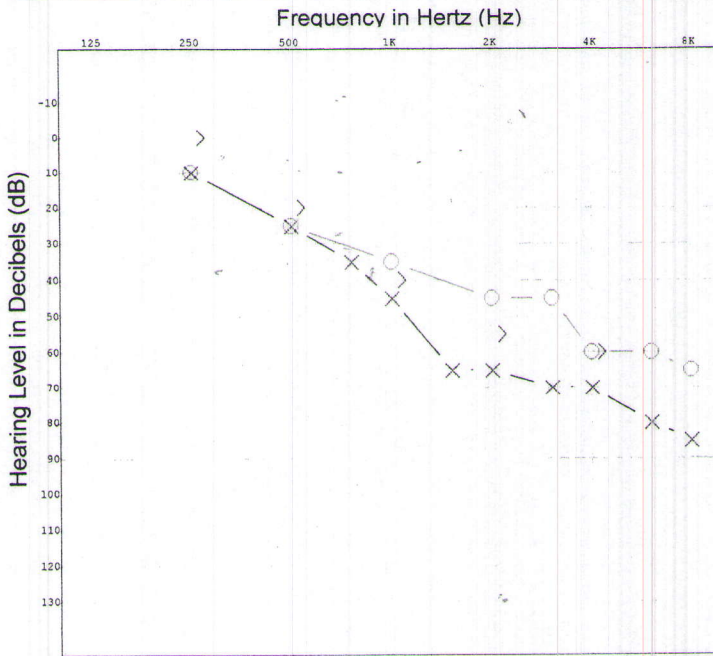

Report Comments

Lionel Bouchard has a sloping, minimal-to-moderate-severe(right)severe(left), low-to-high frequency sensorineural hearing loss, bilaterally. Ooscopic observations were unremarkable, bilaterally. Tympanometry indicated middle ear compliance within normal limits, bilaterally. He reported: difficulty hearing in background noise; occasional "ringing" in both ears; and a history of noise exposure while working with heavy equipment with no hearing protection. His hearing loss is mostly likely due to noise exposure and aging. He is a hearing aid candidate in both ears.
